Military Maps from the 1700s noting the Latin/German names of cities/towns/villages—comprehensive set of hand drawn maps for all areas of Slovenia. . . collection of 6 books with corresponding maps by area

Two-volume set of heraldry books noting the pedigree charts and histories of the nobility who lived in Slovenia. Written in the Slovenian language and has multiple family trees.
